

**Helpful Hints:**  
**Getting to Mount Vernon Hospital**  
Rickmansworth Road, Northwood HA6 2RN

## By Car

### From M25

- Exit M25 at Junction 18 (Chorleywood & Rickmansworth)
- Follow the A404 towards Rickmansworth and Northwood.
- As you approach Northwood, you reach an area of heath with Ye Olde Greene Manne pub on your left.
- Mount Vernon Hospital main entrance is further along on the right.



### From Northwood, Pinner and Harrow

- Follow the A404 towards Rickmansworth.
- As you leave Northwood and drive up the hill, Mount Vernon Hospital is on your left.

### From Uxbridge, Hillingdon and Harefield

- Follow the A40 to the roundabout for the B467 and follow the signs for Harefield into Swakeleys Road.
- At the first roundabout, bear left into Harvil Road. Follow Harvil Road until it becomes Church Road and then High Street.
- At the roundabout in Harefield, turn right towards Northwood and take the first left into Northwood Road.
- Follow this road until it goes through woods (White Hill).
- Gate 3 of Mount Vernon Hospital is on your right.

## Parking

- There are three entrances to Mount Vernon Hospital leading to car parks:
  - Gates 1 and 2 are located on Rickmansworth Road (A404). Both have large car parks.
  - Gate 3 is on White Hill (opposite Ye Olde Greene Manne pub). There are two small car parks.
- Each car park can only be reached through one gate.



A Pay and Display scheme is in operation in all car parks at all times, including evenings and weekends. Please ensure you park in a marked bay otherwise you will be clamped. Pay and Display machines do not give change. A change machine is available in the Oak Tree Restaurant (near Mount Vernon Hospital main entrance – not the Cancer Centre).

Patients attending for cancer treatment are entitled to purchase tokens at a reduced rate. These are available from the Car Park Office near Mount Vernon Hospital main entrance.

## Disabled drivers

Blue badge holders may park in any bay in the public car parks on the site. There is no charge for parking - just display your badge.

There are also designated parking spaces for disabled drivers closer to some of the buildings. These are opposite the main entrance to the Cancer Centre, outside the Minor Injuries Unit, outside the main hospital entrance and outside the Chemotherapy Suite.



No parking is permitted on the roads that run through the hospital.

## By Bus

8: Watford/Abbots Langley – Mount Vernon

282: Ealing Hospital – Eastcote – Northwood Hills – Northwood – Mount Vernon

331: Uxbridge Station – Denham – Harefield – Mount Vernon – Northwood – Ruislip

H11: Harrow – Pinner – Northwood – Mount Vernon

R21: Uxbridge – Denham – Maple Cross – Rickmansworth – Harefield – Mount Vernon

Shuttle bus: This free service runs throughout the day (Monday – Friday) between Hillingdon Hospital (A&E department) and Mount Vernon Hospital (main entrance).



## By Underground

- Take the Metropolitan Line to Northwood station.
- Take the 282, 331 or H11 bus from the station to the Hospital.



## By Train

- Use the Chiltern Railways service to Rickmansworth.
- Take the Metropolitan Line to Northwood station.
- Take the 282, 331 or H11 bus from the station to the Hospital.



Or:

- Use the Chiltern Railways service to Denham.
- Take the 331 bus to the Hospital.

## By Taxi

There is a taxi rank at Mount Vernon Hospital. Some vehicles are suitable for wheelchair users.

## Getting help with paying for transport

## Mount Vernon Cancer Centre Patient Transport Service
